


THIS IS WHAT HAPPENS WHEN CORPORATIONS AND PEOPLE SHARE THE SAME RIGHTS.

(Citizens United v. FEC, 2010)



Businesses can refuse random inspections of their facilities because corporations have a right to privacy and are protected from unreasonable search and seizure.

(Marshall v. Barlow, 1978)




Vermont dairy farmers cannot label their milk free of genetically engineered hormones because doing so interferes with the Monsanto Company's right to silence.

(IDMA v. Amestoy, 1996)



States cannot have laws protecting small businesses from being driven out by large chains because large chains have a right to equal protection.

(Liggett v. Lee, 1933)



Cigarette companies cannot be stopped from advertising within 1000 feet of a school because corporations have a right to free speech.

(Lorillard Tobacco v. Reilly, 2000)
