An individual non-resident may make campaign contributions to candidates or candidates' committees. The aggregate of all such contributions for the benefit of any 1 candidate and that candidate's committee, seeking any State, County, Municipal or other office except for a Federal office, shall not exceed the sum of \$500 in a calendar year; provided, however, that the aggregate of contributions by an individual for the benefit of any 1 candidate and the candidate's committee seeking election to the office of state senator or state representative in a state election who previously, in the same calendar year, sought election to the office of state senator or state representative in a special election, shall not exceed the sum of \$500 during the period beginning on the first day of January and ending on the day of the special election and an additional \$500 during the period that begins on the day after the special election and ends on the last day of December following the special election.

(3) An individual non-resident may make campaign contributions to candidates or candidate's committees for Federal office not to exceed the limits prescribed in (a)(1) while adhering to limits set forth in (a)(2). All candidates and candidate's committees are responsible for keeping track of non-resident contributions and are subject to...
