

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts AN INITIATIVE PETITION FOR A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

Under Article XLVIII of the Amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth

SUMMARY

This proposed amendment to the state constitution would declare that corporations are not people and may be regulated. It would declare that the rights afforded to human residents under the state constitution are not applicable to corporations, limited liability companies, or any other corporate entities. It would declare that the state Legislature has the power to regulate the rights of corporations, limited liability companies, or other corporate entities to do business in the state, in order to promote the common good and strengthen the social compact of the Commonwealth.

The proposed amendment would also declare that money is not free speech

FILING DEADLINES. Initiative petitions must be submitted to local election officials for certification of signatures no later than 5 p.m. on Wednesday, November 20, 2013. Local election officials must complete their certification no later than December 2, 2013. Thereafter, initiative petitions containing certified signatures must be retrieved by petitioners from the local election officials and then filed with the Elections Division, Office of the Secretary of the Commonwealth, One Ashburton Place, Room 1705, Boston, MA, no later than 5 p.m. on Wednesday, December 4, 2013.

and could be regulated to protect the political process and the functioning of government to serve the best interests of the citizens of the Commonwealth. The Legislature would have the power to regulate the raising and spending of money and in-kind equivalents for any primary or election of a public official and for ballot measures. This would include regulation of any advertising for or against any candidate in a primary or election for public office and any ballot measure.

The proposed amendment declares that it could not be applied to restrict the freedom of the press.
