



# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts AN INITIATIVE PETITION FOR A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

Under Article XLVIII of the Amendments to the  
Constitution of the Commonwealth

## SUMMARY


This proposed constitutional amendment would declare that corporations are not people and may be regulated. It would declare that the rights afforded to human inhabitants under the state constitution are not applicable to corporations, corporate entities, or artificial persons. It would declare that the state Legislature has the power to regulate the rights of corporations, corporate entities, or artificial persons to do business in the state in order to promote the common good and strengthen the social compact of the Commonwealth.

The proposed amendment would also declare that the Legislature may

regulate and set reasonable limits on political contributions and expenditures to ensure that all individuals have access to the political process and that no individual gains more access or ability to influence an election of a candidate for public office or a ballot measure. The Legislature would also be obligated to require that permissible contributions and expenditures, including late donations, be publicly disclosed in a timely manner before any vote is held.

The proposed amendment would declare that it could not be applied to restrict the freedom of the press.

**FILING DEADLINES.** Initiative petitions must be submitted to local election officials for certification of signatures no later than **5 p.m. on Wednesday, November 23, 2016**. Local election officials must complete their certification no later than December 5, 2016. Thereafter, initiative petitions containing certified signatures must be retrieved by petitioners from the local election officials and then filed with the Elections Division, Office of the Secretary of the Commonwealth, One Ashburton Place, Room 1705, Boston, MA, no later than **5 p.m. on Wednesday, December 7, 2016**.
