ADJOURNED SESSION TUESDAY, April 10, 2012 at 7:00 PM**

At a legal meeting of the qualified voters of the Town of Tisbury held April 3, 2012 and the adjourned session held April 10, 2012, the following action was taken to support Massachusetts Senate bill S 772:

A motion was made, seconded and voted to take action on an article not on the warrant. A motion was made, seconded, and voted that the voters of Tisbury express their support of Representative Tim Madden and Senator Dan Wolf in their efforts to pass Massachusetts Senate bill S.772. This bill was introduced by Senator James B. Eldridge and calls for a constitutional amendment to overturn the 2010 Citizens United vs Federal Election Commission (FEC) Supreme Court ruling, thereby restoring our country's democracy by establishing that corporations are not persons, and that uncontrolled and unidentified election contributions (by 'super PACs') are not allowable.
